### **The Cancer Education, Information and Support Service (CEISS)**

The Cancer Education, Information and Support Service (CEISS) at Stoke Mandeville Hospital and Wycombe Hospital provides information and support to anyone who has concerns about cancer, their relatives, friends and carers. The service is staffed by health professionals and supported by trained volunteers.

The cancer information areas are situated in the Cancer Care and Haematology Unit at Stoke Mandeville Hospital and the Sunrise Cancer Unit at Wycombe Hospital.

You are welcome to come and visit our information areas with free guided internet access available (Stoke Mandeville Hospital only). Our information materials are free or can be borrowed, and some are suitable for people with special needs or are available in different languages.

We can put you in touch with complementary therapists, benefits advisors, and other local and national support groups. We also have facilities for support meetings, group relaxation sessions and wig fittings.

We also run the Moving on with Confidence course. This six week course is aimed at helping patients at the end of their active treatment; adjust to life after cancer treatment. The focus is on three main themes: Emotional, Practical and Physical effects of cancer. The aim of this course is to enable you to deal with problems and move on with more confidence.
